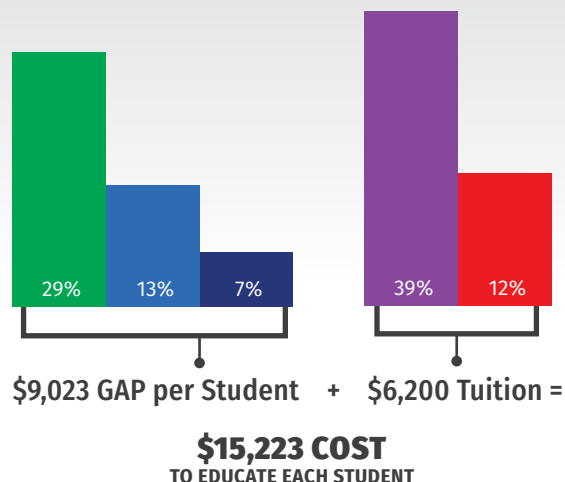
Did you know? It costs **\$15,223** to educate your child.

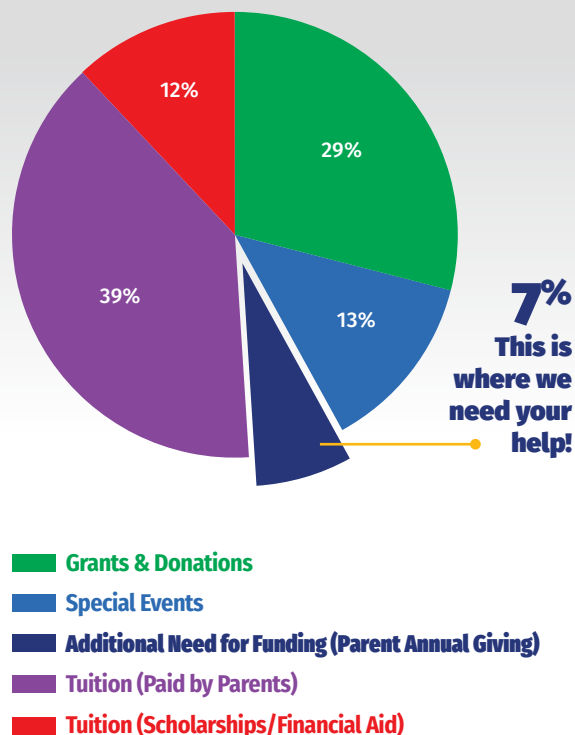
